

PAINTING FOR BEGINNERS – MATERIALS LIST

PAINTS

If you already own some, you may bring to the first session and your teacher will advise what else you may need.

Select the paint you would like to learn with (oil, acrylics or both) in the following colours:

- Titanium White
- Lemon Yellow
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Spectrum Vermillion

Optional extra colours:

- Spectrum Crimson
- Phthalo Blue

PALETTE

• Plastic plates or container lids, white and flat

BRUSHES

For painting with ACRYLICS:

- Selection of approx. 6 brushes; some flat and some round (various sizes between 1 to 12)
- One 4 to 5 cm flat brush

For painting with OIL:

- Hog bristle brushes, round and inexpensive ones (sizes: 4, 6 and 12)
- Synthetic brushes, round and inexpensive ones (sizes: 4 and 6)

PENCIL & PAPER

- 4B pencil
- Some sheets of A4 drawing paper
- Canvas painting pad, A3

MISCELLANEOUS

- Plastic knives for mixing
- Glass jar with lid
- Cotton rags
- Oil painters only: A small bottle of linseed oil or stand oil
